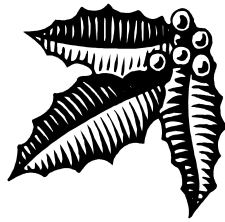


Parents Newsletter No. 4 Christmas 2007

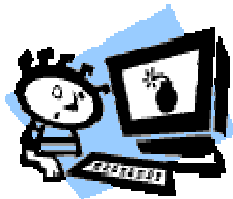
